Next week is WEEK 5- July 1- July 5: FUN AND GAMES

Games give kids the opportunity to have fun and learn that games and rules that need to be followed as well as giving them a chance to learn that sometimes they win and sometimes they don't. Learning how to loose and trying again is an important life skill we will practice with board games, paper games and gym games.

WEEK 6 - July 8-12: WET AND MESSY

Like getting messy? This week we will have fun with both wet and messy art, games and projects. Make sure to send kids in clothes that can get wet and messy.

It is in the name of the week, but to be clear, Week 6 will be wet and messy. Send clothes that can get messy and possibly wet each day your child attends. You may choose to send extra clothes daily.

Some days may be more wet, some may be more messy, some WILL BE BOTH. Daily activities will be weather dependent. Possible wet and messy items include paint (including a project named splat painting), shaving cream, flour (one game for older students will include getting covered in flour) slime (which can stain clothes if it happens to get on them, which we do try to avoid).

Some projects are messy to clean up but not necessarily messy for the clothes like rice art & Play-Doh.

The Thursday "Event" is a magic show called "Wet and Wild". For that day, students should be prepared to have a water day like Tuesdays. I don't know how wet it will get. If it happens to be a rainy day, the magic show will change to be indoors and a different theme, but will still happen at the same time which is 1:00-3:00.
