ATTENDANCE / FEES

There are no minimum days or hours of attendance for Summer Daze. All fees are paid by auto deduct from your bank account on file each Wednesday, following the week of Care provided. Payments not honored by the bank will incur a \$30 fee. Please note that any account that becomes two (2) weeks in arrears, a \$30 late fee will be charged to your account. If fees are not brought current, or payment arrangements have not been made, at the principal's discretion, the student/s may not be allowed to attend the program until the account is current.

The Following Options are available:

Each Full day (over 6 hours) = \$55 or

Each Half day (6 hour maximum) = \$45

FIELD TRIPS

Field Trips / At School Events are planned and announced in the spring. An Additional Field Trip cost of \$13 per trip per student will be applied to your account for each event attended and auto paid with the weekly fees due.

Alternate supervision is not available at the school in the event that a child may not want to attend a field trip. All participants for the day must pay the additional fee for the trip/ Event.

HOURS OF OPERATION

Summer Daze will be open June 3 – August 9, 2024 from 7 a.m. until 6 p.m., Monday through Friday with the exception of Thursday, July 4th and Friday, July 5th. Summer Daze's last day is Friday, August 9, 2024.

REGISTRATION

Registration fee is \$80.00 for the first child and \$50.00 for each additional child in the immediate family. Registration fees and all required paperwork must be received before your child is considered enrolled in Summer Daze. Registration fees are non-refundable.
