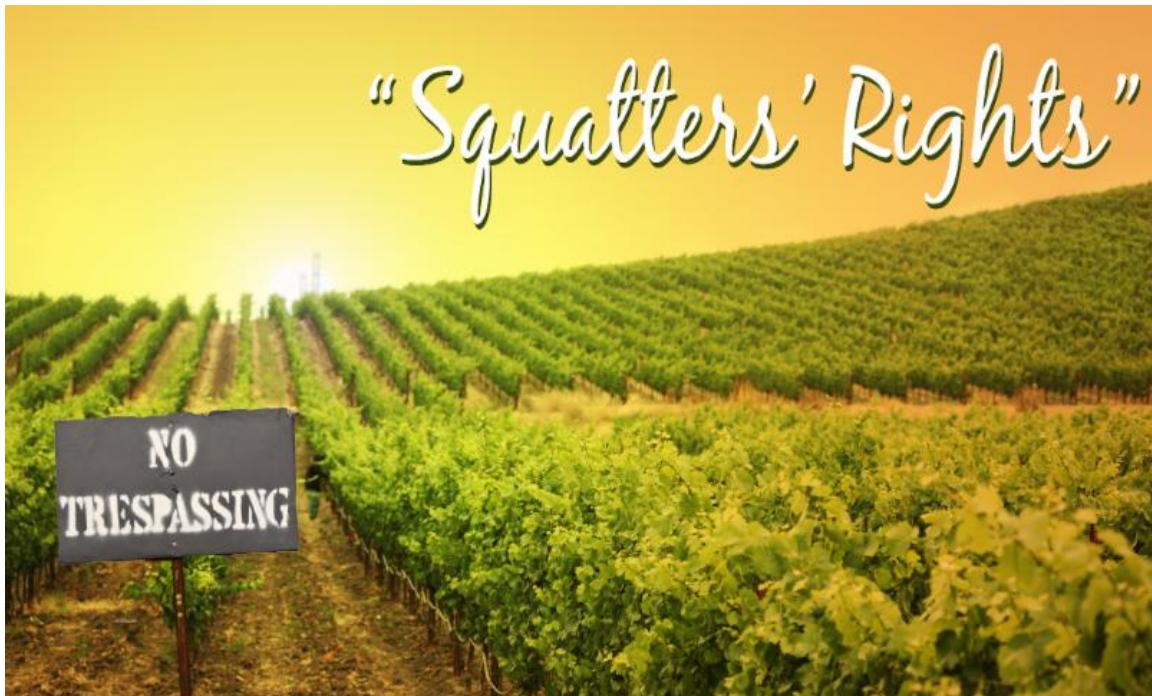

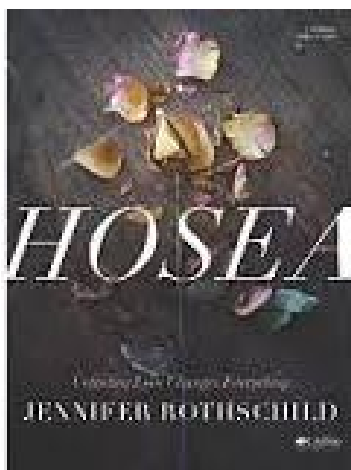

### **THURSDAY EVENING WOMEN'S BIBLE STUDY: Unfailing Love Changes Everything**

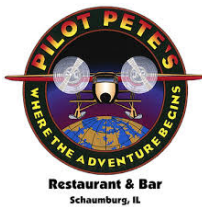

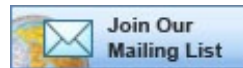
